# Message from Our CEO

This was an exciting year for the Okanagan tech community and Team AO. We saw a strong return to in-person programs and tech community events, happening throughout the region. There is a buzz in our innovation hubs with an increase in tenancy and meeting room bookings in both our Kelowna and Vernon locations. We were also able to host our New Year Kick Off celebration for the first time since the pandemic. We had a sold-out event and an enthusiastic crowd of 350 community leaders, AO alumni, and newcomers to Okanagan tech.

Over the past year, one key focus for our team was addressing challenges in the talent landscape, which we had seen increase in complexity during the pandemic. We hosted community and entrepreneur roundtables, compensation workshops, and had 67 local companies participate in the Workforce Insights Salary and Compensation Study, giving them insights into salary data from across Canada through our partners at Bench Market.

We held the 5th annual Okanagan Angel Summit which continues to grow year over year. We celebrated with the largest cheque size to date; \$225,000 was invested into SMRT1 Technologies, headquartered in Nelson, BC. Since its inception in 2019, the Summit has trained 98 Okanagan-based angel investors, and supported 168 Western Canadian companies, with \$805,000 being directly invested through the five Angel Summit funds.

Looking ahead, we see a real need to foster a new wave of startups that are emerging in the Okanagan. We are working to refresh our Acceleration Stack of a program that will encourage more peer connection and in-person mentorship opportunities with an increase in capital education. We have an incredible amount of entrepreneurial talent in our region and we can't wait to see what the next year holds.

This year, the OKGN Angel Summit attracted over 45 companies from across Western Canada, and 43 Okanagan-based investors who created a fund of \$225K - the largest fund in the program's 5-year history. Companies from various industries including artificial intelligence, robotics, medical innovations, health & wellness, and consumer packaged goods had the opportunity to compete for a chance to take home the big cheque. At the live finale on March 16, SMRT1 Technologies, secured the \$225K investment fund.
